How 2+2 Works

- The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Agriculture at WIU. Students will fill out applications for both schools, consult the advisors and catalogs from both schools for specifics. This completion guide is designed to ensure graduation in four years by taking courses at both BHC and WIU. This guide assumes students have met all course prerequisites required by BHC and admission requirements for WIU.
- Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at BHC, students will receive an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree. Students will be required to complete the Agricultural core requirements at WIU, and upon completion of the final two years' curriculum requirements students will receive the B.S. degree with a major in Agriculture - Agricultural Science at WIU. In general, a minimum of 60 semester hours (s.h.) will be taken at BHC at BHC rates and 60 s.h. from WIU at WIU rates.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 should be achieved by the junior year. These grade point averages must be maintained for graduation as an Agriculture - Agricultural Science major.

- 1. Minimum of 60 hours required to complete the Associate of Arts degree.
- Grades of "C" or better are required for ENG 101 and ENG 102
- 3. To meet both BHC and WIU requirements, 3 of the following 4 AG Electives must be completed: 1) AG 282(4 hrs.); 2) AG 283(4 hrs.) or HORT 284(3 hrs.); 3) AG 285 (4 hrs.); and 4) AG 287(4 hrs.).
- BHC requires completion of a Non-Western studies course. Course options are available as an IAI Humanities, Fine Arts, or Social and Behavioral Science course. Consult BHC Advisor for course options.

- 9. Must have 49 hours of Ag Coursework with at least 24 hours taken at WIU
- WIU Directed Science can be selected from (if not already completed): BOT 200; MICR 200; ZOOL 200; CHEM 102 or CHEM 202; GIS 108; GEOL 110; GEOG 121; METR 120; PHYS 114, PHYS 115, and/or PHYS 211

Black Hawk College and Western Illinois University agree that if a student completes the Associate of **Arts** and is admitted to Western Illinois University, that student shall be eligible for this Articulation Agreement.

- This Articulation Agreement is only appropriate for students who transfer from Black Hawk
 College with an Associate of Arts that includes the general education courses, that are attached to
 this document, and who pursue a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agriculture-Agricultural
 Science major from Western Illinois University. The series of courses that must be taken to
 complete the baccalaureate degree at WIU are attached to this document.
- 2. The student must satisfactorily complete the course requirements at Western Illinois University to earn a *Bachelor of Science in Agriculture- Agricultural Science major*.
- 3. Students admitted under this 2+2 Agreement must meet all other graduation requirements as listed in the student undergraduate catalog at Western Illinois University.
- 4. If either *Black Hawk College* or Western Illinois University changes major program requirements, general education requirements, graduation requirements, this agreement is subject to renegotiation.
